Implementation Designers are responsible for initiating and supporting creative direction on material selection and specifications with team members of varying disciplines to demonstrate a variety of viable solutions. This requires presentation of material solutions to both project teams and clients.

- Knowledge of construction documentation production, coordination, and conceptual detailing.

- Ability to clearly and effectively communicate with the Project Lead regarding task completion and/or project challenges as they arise.

- Experience producing material/finish submittal boards, both physical and digital.
- Experience creating and organizing project finish schedules.
- Experience coordinating and establishing new relationships with third-party vendors and ordering samples and maintaining the internal materials library.
- Knowledge of building codes, ADA, and construction specifications.
- Proficient in Revit modeling and documentation.
- Working knowledge of CAD.
- Familiarity with Adobe Creative Suite.
